General Consequences for Code of Ethics Infractions

First Offense: **Restricted Use for 1 day**
Second Offense: **Restricted Use for 1 week & parent phone conference**
Third Offense: **In-person parent conference & long-term "Restricted Use"**

What does "Restricted Use" mean?

"Restricted Use" means that a laptop may only be utilized during the school day in order to complete mandatory assignments. The laptop may not go home. The student must check out the laptop when needed, and the unit must be returned before the end of the school day. There are both short and long term restrictions. Longer term restriction periods may be applied depending on the incident severity and/or infraction frequency.

What does long-term "Restricted Use" mean?

The length of "Restricted Use" will be determined by the severity of the "Code of Ethics" infraction. Serious infractions may result in suspending privileges for the entire school year.

Consequences for Specific Infraction

Inappropriate websites accessed:

- 2 week "Restricted Use" and parent phone or in-person conference.

Cleared history folder:

- 2 week "Restricted Use" and parent phone or in-person conference.

Altered parental controls or serious laptop damage:

- 1 month "Restricted Use" and parent phone or in-person conference.
